Saving Animals Using AI

In countries around the world, wild animals are losing their homes to humans. Cities are growing and factories are being built all over, and climate change is making it harder to protect these animals. This is because the areas where they ^{※1}used to be able to live are either too hot or too dry and are no longer ^{※2}suitable for them.

In Africa, poaching — which means killing animals for their skin, horns, or ^{※3}tusks — is another ^{※4}threat that wild animals are facing. Human beings are making life extremely difficult for African animals, but some people have () their lives protecting these animals. People who study and protect animals are called conservationists.

Recently, people working as conservationists in Africa have started to use technology, including GPS satellites and AI (Artificial Intelligence) to find animals that are in danger and ^{※5}track them ^{※6}so that they can keep the animals safe. Scientists are also working with local people and “citizen scientists”. These are people who live in areas where wildlife is under threat and want to help by ^{※7}keeping a record of the wild animals around them. One example of this is the Wild Book project.

Wild Book tracks wildlife by collecting many photos of the animals from scientists, volunteers and tourists. Different animals can be tracked through these images for a very long time so that ^{※8}researchers can learn more about animals' ^{※9}behavior and count the number of animals in an area. Wildbook's technology lets scientists ^{※10}recognize each animal from a photograph. The project plans to create a huge list of animals that live in areas around the world so that they can be protected, but it will take many years for this to happen.

Staying Safe Online

The Internet has changed our world over the past few ^{※1}decades and almost all people in Japan use ^{※2}devices like computers, smart phones, or tablets, that connect to the Internet every day. People use the Internet to do their work, watch movies, or buy things online, and communicate with their friends and family. However, the Internet can also be dangerous.

In the past ten years, millions of people around the world have been ^{※3}affected by cyber ^{※4}crimes. These are bad things that ^{※5}criminals do by using the Internet. Some criminals use ^{※6}fake websites to ^{※7}cheat people into spending money online. Other common online crimes are fake emails and computer viruses called malware that can steal our personal information. Criminals also use SNS to communicate with honest citizens and ^{※8}do them harm.

The risk of being **a victim** of cyber crimes makes the Internet sound ^{※9}scary, but there are a few things we can do to use electronic devices safely. These include installing ^{※10}antivirus software on our devices, not opening emails from people we don't know, only shopping online at well-known websites, being extremely careful when we communicate using SNS, and never talking to strangers online.

The Internet is here to stay, and we can use it for many useful purposes. Being careful online is the best way to use the Internet safely without having to worry about criminals.
