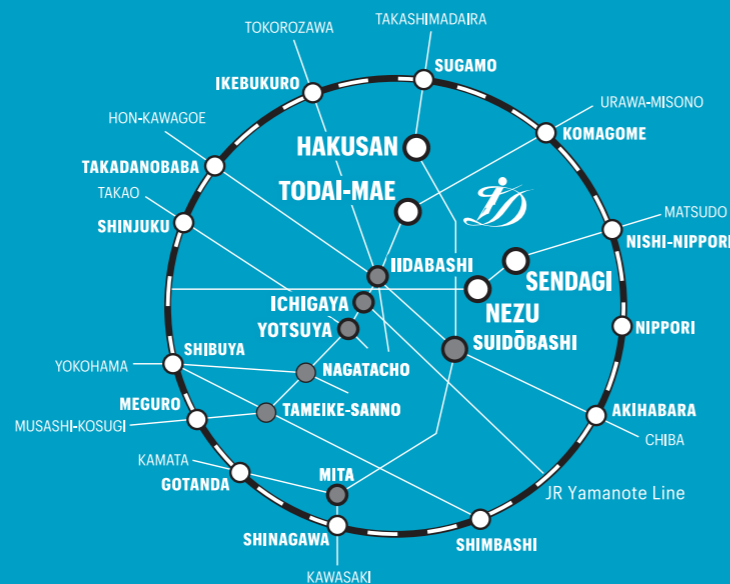

Unique Educational Programs of Global Leader Advanced Class

Bilingual Immersion

Dual-Teacher Homeroom System

Homeroom classes are led by both an International teacher and a Japanese teacher.

Proficiency-Based English Tracks

English classes are split into Honors Foundation (All-English) and Liberal Arts Foundation (English/Japanese bilingual) based on proficiency.

Half-Immersion STEM

Subjects like Science and Math (from 2027) are taught in both Japanese and English. Core concepts are taught in Japanese, while deeper exploration and experiments are conducted in English.

All-English Assembly

A monthly joint assembly with the Global High School. Students lead discussions on global affairs and challenges.
